Our Nursery

Two Year Olds - Chicks

Sandbank Nursery School offer places for 2 year olds;

- Funded 2 Year places (15hr) - families receiving government support
- Funded 2 year places (15hr) - Working Families
- Fee Paying Places: £9 per 3 hr session (either am/pm)

Our nursery provides exciting learning environments both indoors and out with exciting learning opportunities for our youngest children.

The children are assigned a key worker who they spend their group time with. They sing nursery rhymes, read books and do language activities together. The environment is designed and resourced with appropriate toys to meet all the areas of learning.

Children have a range of exciting activities indoors and out. They will paint, build, ride bikes, climb and enjoy messy play. Please send your child in clothing suitable for all weathers. We use aprons but children will sometimes get wet or dirty. A separate set of clothes is always helpful.

Three and Four year olds

The nursery classrooms are carefully arranged with age appropriate toys in place. There is a key worker system to ensure that your child feels safe and belongs in our school. Positive relationships are important between children, staff and families and we pride ourselves on always putting the children at the heart of everything we do.



The children are taught Maths and Phonics each day and have activities planned to meet the needs of the children and their interests as well as the seasons and celebrations throughout the year. They also have activities planned around stories, songs and rhymes. They are given opportunities each day to learn indoors and outdoors.

- We have some children who are our rising three's we call these N1's.
- We have children who are in our pre-school which we call N2's.

All day children - 30 hour Provision



If your child is entitled to 30-hour provision you need to provide a code. Eligible children can stay from 8.30am until 3.30pm, parents provide a packed lunch and pay £3.00 for the lunchtime supervision.

These children have a different curriculum in the afternoons and work together for their enrichment hours.

Snack Money



A contribution of £1.50 is collected weekly which helps to pay for healthy snacks, fruit, cooking ingredients, presents for the children, special events in school and helps subsidise school trips.

You are welcome to pay this termly at a discounted rate of £15 per term.

What your child needs to bring to school



Please bring a coat and a bag with a change of clothes, nappies and wipes (if needed) and clothes appropriate for the weather, hats and gloves and coats in the winter and sunhats and cream in the summer.

Uniform

School uniform is available for you to purchase from the school office.

Jumpers & Cardigans £10 each - Polo T-shirts £6 each (*Uniform is optional*)

Please ensure that your **child's clothes are named** so that things that are taken off go home with the right child.

Medication



No medication is given in school. The exception is for those children with specific medical needs such as Asthma medication or for Diabetes care.

Password

We have a Password System in place should someone other than yourself collect your child. Please make sure the person collecting knows the password to tell the key worker.



Safeguarding

At Sandbank Nursery School we believe that every child has the right to protection from abuse and neglect. All staff have training in keeping children safe and have a duty to follow the Walsall Child Protection procedures if they have any concerns. It is our priority to make sure children are safe and healthy.

All staff have a responsibility to safeguard your children and would report their concerns to the listed staff.

Encompass

We are taking part in a jointly run operation between Walsall Council, West Midlands Police and schools, called Operation Encompass, this means that we are notified by the police, when they are called out to a domestic property where our children reside.
